FINDING HER COURAGE - SEEING HER WORTH

The night *Olivia saw her pregnancy test show positive; her heart sank. Her love-life had been a string of toxic relationships where physical and verbal abuse were the norm, and most of the friendships she had formed were laced in manipulation and selfishness. Parties and heavy drinking had become her only escape and one such party ended in a one-night stand with a man she never intended to form a relationship with.

When she contacted the father, he demanded she get an abortion - never even asking what she wanted for herself. To her own surprise, she found herself hesitating and decided to get all the information she could before making her final decision. She knew that once her decision was made, she could not turn back.

The moment she saw her baby moving and squirming on the ultrasound, a fierce love came over her and she began to feel something both foreign and beautiful... hope.

On that day, something within her changed. For the first time in her life, Olivia found herself wanting more. She wanted more out of life, more from her so-called friends, and more from men who had never valued her. It occurred to her that her daughter would be watching her, and mimicking what she saw. How could she expect her daughter to have healthy relationships, and friendships in which she was valued and treated with respect, if she never modeled that in her own life? This reality hit like a freight train, and slowly she began to change everything. "I am trying to become the woman I want my daughter to be, and have only relationships that I would be proud for her to have."

When Olivia came to Pregnancy Care Center, we spoke to her of her own value and potential. We reminded her that she is enough she is strong and smart enough to not only survive motherhood, but



to succeed and thrive. She could still get an education and chase her dreams. She could show her daughter that women are courageous and capable, and with God's help, they can achieve whatever they set their minds to.

When she left our clinic, Olivia felt a purpose and worth that she had never felt before. She felt confidence, knowing that she would not be on this journey alone - we were able to inform her of the tremendous amount of resources and support she had from us and so many amazing organizations in our community.

It is stories like this, that make us extra grateful for our amazing givers, who sacrifice so much so that we can meet the needs of patients like Olivia.

We hope to inspire our patients to make all of their decisions with courage and confidence, rather than out of fear or desperation. The transformation that we see our patients go through is truly astounding. Women and men who walk through our doors feeling trapped and hopeless, leave feeling empowered and capable of greatness, through the power of our great God.


Baby Bottle Boomerang

This year, January through October, more than 80 men came to PCC with the mother of their unborn child, or alone, needing services for children in their care. This is a direct result of our clinic purposefully reaching out to men as we promote abundant life through the fatherhood initiative. Below is a true story about one of the men who received unconditional love and support through PCC: A young father came into our center after unexpectedly receiving custody of his young child. We had the opportunity to meet with him one-on-one and point out

to him his strengths and capabilities - reminding him of all the things he was doing right.

When we brought out the bags with supplies for his child, he burst into tears as he said, "thank you" over and over. He left with his head held high and feeling confident in his ability to be a strong leader and parent.

God bestows both Motherhood AND Fatherhood. We seek to help these Fathers find their courage. Here is an actual quote from his exit interview:

"You guys are a Godsend; I was scared I wasn't ready or prepared."

VERY ABORTION-MINDED

Recently, a woman came into our office who was strongly considering abortion. She had been sexually active with several men and felt that if the father of the baby was a particular partner, she would carry to term. But, if the other man had fathered the child, she would choose abortion. I am unsure if the patient had completely processed the reality that, in her way of thinking, the timing of conception determined whether the child lived or died.

When we performed the ultrasound, the mom was faced with the reality that she was carrying a small person inside of her womb. She also had to come to terms with the gravity of her decision and its effect on her life and that of her unborn child. By the time we finished her sonogram she was wanting to see more of her child. Since she was only 4 or 5 weeks along we could only see limited features on the monitor. So, we scheduled a follow-up appointment at which she was able to see her 7 week old baby in much more detail. When she saw her baby's heart beating she said, "oh my gosh, that's in me?" She became excited and said, "no matter who the father is, I'm going to keep this baby." She went on to give the baby an endearing nickname. The details of this patient's life-style may seem foreign to some of our readers. I can only imagine what has transpired in the woman's life to bring her to such a place for her to choose to be sexually active with multiple partners....
